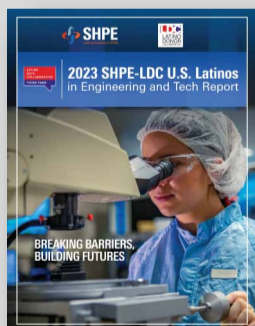
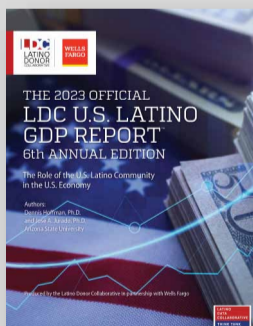
Collaboration & Distribution
